Foundation (Prep) 2018

We have already received many enrolments for Foundation (Prep) 2018. If you have a child starting school next year, I would encourage you to complete an enrolment form prior to the end of Term 2, Friday 30th June. Enrolment forms can be downloaded from our website or collected from the school office. If you know of anyone who could benefit from this information, could you please pass it on. Our next information session will be held on Thursday 8th June, commencing at 1.30pm. We invite all interested families to attend.

If you have a younger child who attends another kinder other than our local one, or a Child Care Centre, would you please assist the school by calling into the school office and requesting some of our brochures and flyers to display at your child's facility. Many families have done this already and we thank you. It is in the best interests of the school to obtain as many enrolments as possible. If you know our brochures are not in your kinder or centre then please contact me to arrange this.

Uniform

There has been a big improvement in the number of children wearing correct uniform. Taking pride in our school, our uniform and our programs is extremely important. Please encourage children to wear uniform at all times, particularly on excursions and sports days.

Lunchtime Clubs

Did you know that we offer a variety of Lunch Time Clubs for students to participate in? These activities include games, dance, chess, art, colouring and others. These activities provide a change from the playground and allow students to participate in some quiet lunchtime activities.

Digimaker Club Club

Last week I sent home a notice from Digimaker. They would like to provide a Computer Club after school on Tuesdays in Term 3. If you would like your child to be involved please return the Expression of Interest by tomorrow, Friday 2nd June. There is a cost involved for this activity.

Sick Children

The dreaded cold months are here and with this, comes the bugs and germs that cause all of us to feel "under the weather" at some point or another. Can I please ask that if your child is not well (cough, sneezes, running nose, temperatures etc.) that you keep them home. This not only benefits your child, but their classmates too, as we want to prevent any illnesses from being spread. There is currently "Hand, Foot & Mouth" disease in some schools. The most common symptoms include high temperature, sore throat, small blister-like lesions that may occur on the inside of the mouth, palms of hands, fingers and soles of feet. The time between contact with the virus and the start of symptoms is about 3-7 days. It is transmitted by a person sneezing, coughing or blowing their nose near you, or contact with something touched by the virus, e.g. toy, door knob etc. There is no specific treatment for the infection other than symptom relief, i.e. Panadol, bed rest and drinking plenty of fluids. Thank you for your understanding.

Before And After School Supervision

A reminder to parents that students should not be in the schoolyard unsupervised before 8.45am. Parents are more than welcome to our school earlier with their children but MUST supervise their own children until 8.45am. The before schoolyard duty teacher begins at 8.45am and concludes at 9.00am.

After school, yard duty begins at 3.30pm until 3.45pm. Please help us to ensure student safety by leaving the school grounds by this time, so that the yard duty teacher is able to ascertain which students have yet to be picked up. We appreciate your support and vigilance around drop off and pick-up times.

Computer Programming Club

In a world where technology touches every aspect of our lives, it is crucial that our children understand how it works. To accomplish this objective, there is an exciting after school club to teach **Computer Programming** that has been offered to Kingsbury Primary School, starting in Term 3, 2017.

The aim of the club is to provide students with exposure to the fundamentals of computer science concepts.

Run by third party provider Digimaker, this program will:

- Build games, animations, stories utilizing pupil's creative thinking
- Develop logical thinking and problem-solving skills
- Express ideas & boost confidence working in a collaborative environment
- Enable the grasp of computational thinking which combines math and logic
