Curriculum Day Reflection

On Monday, Kingsbury teachers and ES support staff attended a workshop run by Berry Street as part of our Berry Street Education Model. In Semester 1, the focus was on The Body. Students have learnt to self-regulate, to listen to their own body, to develop stamina for learning through brain activities and to be Ready to Learn each day.

This Semester, the focus is on Relationships. Relationships between students and relationships between teachers and students. In any school and any workplace people need to be able to work with and respect each other. This unit will fit very well with our school values of Respect, Teamwork and Collaboration, Learning, Friendship and Safety.
