Professional Development

On Tuesday, I took three staff members to participate in a Professional Learning opportunity. We have been granted funding to participate in a Department of Education and Training program called Respectful Relationships. This is a new initiative for 2017 and has been implemented as a response to family violence by the Andrews State Government. All staff, students and community members are expected to behave respectfully in our school. Curriculum will be implemented across all classrooms and in line with our Berry Street Education Model, students will be encouraged to develop positive relationships with each other. I look forward to sharing more with you as resources and programs are rolled out.
